Discussed updates on ISBE Guidance...

- Districts must ensure eligible students transitioning from Early Intervention to Early Childhood have services in place by the student's third birthday, but districts have flexibility in meeting this requirement.
- Students may be provided with remote instruction if they did not meet the October 15 deadline for proof of immunizations and physicals.

- Fall sports are wrapping up and winter sports are set to begin in November and the level of risk depends on whether sports can engage in practice, intrasquad scrimmages, or competition with other teams.
- IHSA recently submitted a plan to IDPH and the Governor's office proposing changes that would impact winter sports.
