- The Supreme Court may hear a case on addressing behaviors that occur outside of school on electronic platforms. The CDC changed the definition of close contact and transmission guidance, aligning it with the approach already used by the IDPH. IDPH released an updated decision tree with minor changes regarding COVID testing and negative diagnoses.
