Discussed ESSER II funding. . .

- Illinois was issued its allocation of the second round of COVID relief funding and schools have been provided with preliminary allocations this week and funds may potentially be received by the end of the month.
- ESSER funds are allocated by the Title I formula but there is broader flexibility in spending, as these funds are not subject to Title I requirements.
- Funds may be used to address needs such as learning loss and preparing for in-person learning.

Discussed the IDPH updated exclusion decision tree and guidance. . .

- IDPH has provided updated guidance based on CDC recommendations, but decisions about quarantine timelines are left up to local health departments.
- Other updates include definitions of an outbreak, guidance on necessary documentation to return to school, guidance on travel, and an updated exclusion chart.

- The pandemic may result in changes to your staffing plan for next year.
- Districts should be thinking about the staffing plan now, including the need for a Reduction in Force and changing job descriptions.
- It is important to collaborate with the union now about any potential changes for next year.

Discussed FAQs about special education during COVID...

- We have seen an increase in state complaints and due process requests related to the pandemic and districts tend to be in a good position to defend these claims when they have good documentation, use data, and provide clear communication.
- Districts should anticipate requests for grade retention due to the pandemic and should be aware of and follow the district's typical process to respond to these requests.

Discussed vaccine schedule updates. . .

- Illinois is currently providing vaccines to individuals in group 1a, but should be moving to group 1b soon.
- Éducators are second in line in group 1b, following first responders, and we anticipate more information about what this will look like soon. We will keep you posted as we learn more.
